- The Animal Shelter has been performing its regular activities. The Shelter team has done remarkably this month with over two hundred and fifty spaying and neutering of dogs and over one fifty cats. This is the highest recorded number of spaying this year in one month. Thanks to Dr. Deo Pandey and team.



- The Animal Birth Control (ABC) Programme has been going in full swing at the Shelter. Almost every day, the Animal Birth Control Prg. is being conducted as there are many owner dogs who need to be spayed. The KAS team calls owners a day prior to ABC if their appointments are booked. Some of the rescued street dogs too are sterilised on ABC day. This way, a little donation is also raised.

Flu season, Parvovirus and Distemper are rampant in dogs

- A lot of cases continue to come at the Animal Shelter Clinic. These four-legged sick outpatients are being checked and treated by the Vet and team. Most of them are put on saline and antibiotics to help them fight the viral disease. As saline water is cold for the dogs to take, the Animal Shelter team for ages now has been warming it with hot water in a jar so that the dogs are not so cold.



- The ABC kennels at KAS are full with rescues and lactating mothers who are surrendered to the Shelter. The puppies are not old enough to get adopted. Once they wean, they will be put up for adoption by the team as usual. The female dogs then will also be spayed and released.



- On Sunday, a Village camp was held at Kol Bong, a far off village from Kalimpong. Few cats and dogs were spayed at camp there. Dr. Pandey and team were also felicitated at Kol Bong camp for their hard work.
